Structure has a distinctive entrance opening where the keystone of the arch is made of wood and is part of the storm doors. It also has a double bracketed cornice and frieze windows. Other windows are rectangular with stone lintels and sills. The front first floor windows descend to the floor. There is a hip roof. (Gardner Museum Survey 1987)

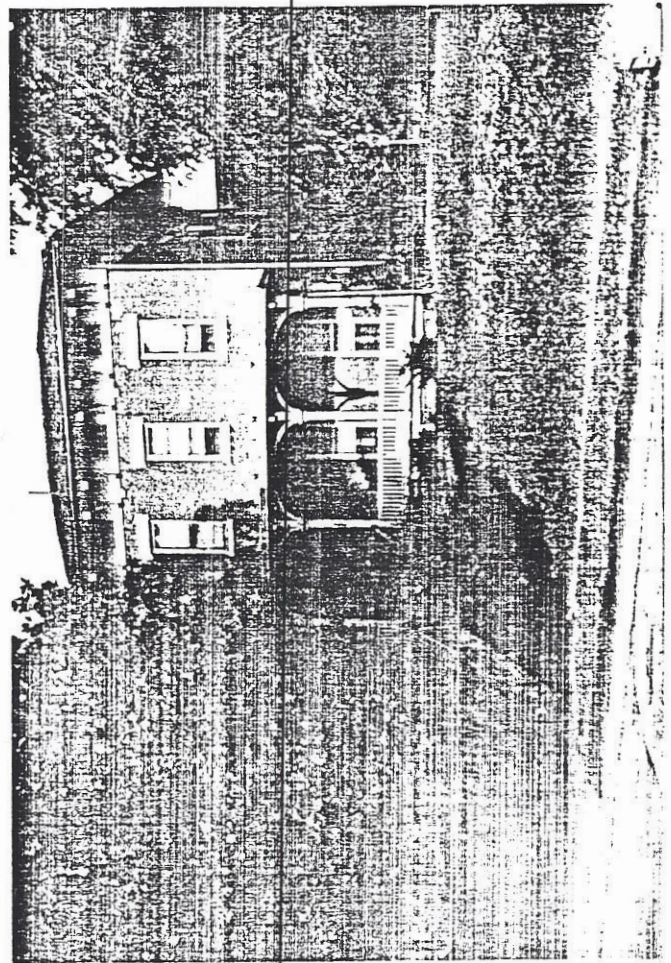
