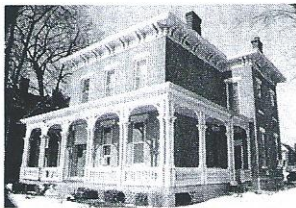


9 *George T. Meyer House* *323 College Street*



Built in 1866 by George T. Meyer, a self-made businessman, this Italianate two-story house is adorned by a wrap-around front

porch, wooden shutters, and large cornices with paired brackets. It is identical in style, massing, and craftsmanship to the Fries/Kespohl House at 331 College Street. The Meyer House is significant as a typical middle-class residence of the post-Civil War period. The house has remained largely unaltered since its construction.
