

11 *James and Sarah Margaret Bradshaw House*

819 North 5th Street



Constructed in 1879, the house is locally known as the “House of Many Gables,” a name derived from the fifteen dormers that enliven the roofline of its two and one-half stories. Over the

rectangular windows and doors are dogtoothed limestone hoods, each with a central carving. Of Eastlake style, it is an outstanding example of High Victorian eclecticism and a major North Side residential landmark.
