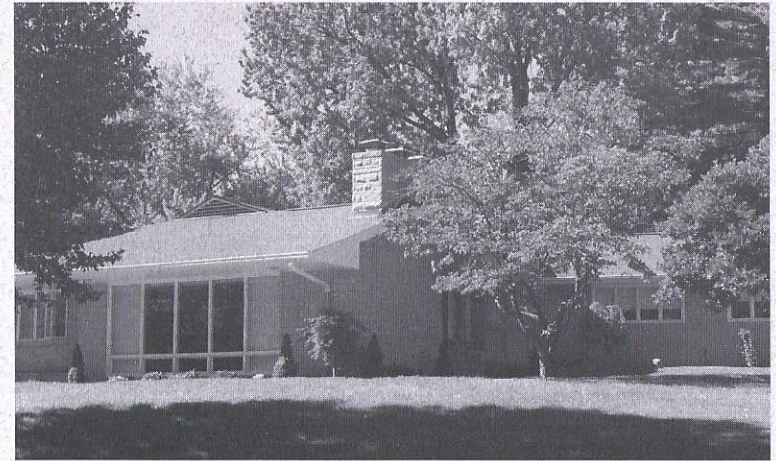


2436 Country Club Drive N.
Mid Century Modern • 1952 • Jack Hafner, Architect
Erman and Winnie Ingram House

This Mid-Century Modern style house, built in 1952, sits on what was once a golf course. Though the exterior of the house is very unassuming, many large windows reflect the concept of bringing the outdoors inside. The inside is a lovely example of many things considered “modern” in 1952, including some period furniture added by the present owners. The roof is level, but the house is built on a slope, which causes the ceilings of each room to rise from one end of the house to the other. The ceilings range from a height of 10 feet to 15 feet.

Originally designed as a two bedroom home, the blueprints show the changes made to include a third bedroom. All closets are cedar lined and contain drawers, making bedroom dressers unnecessary.

This house was purchased from the Ingrams’ daughter, so only 3 owners have resided here. Very few changes have been made to the original house.

Mr. and Mrs. Charles Heidbreder House

This neighbor of the Tour’s other ‘50’s ranch follows the plan chosen by Mrs. Heidbreder from American Magazine. Quincy architect Frank Horn assisted in accommodating the design for a family of six musicians, who each needed an area to practice in. This 4 bedroom house, with very large windows to encase the outside landscaping, was built in 1956-57.

The exterior is a combination of Indiana Bedford stone and redwood. The striated side of the redwood, now painted, is seen on the exterior and the flat side is on the interior. Exceptionally wide, seven-foot eaves protect the east side. The curve of the house fits the shape of the lot perfectly.

Similar to the house next door, a sloping lot and level roof necessitated having the rooms at varying levels. A central hall provides accessibility to all wings; it is close to the stairway leading to the basement. A covered area between the house and garage forms a pleasant patio in the spacious back yard.
