The focus is on the SW corner tower with conical roof; porch is dominated by heavy bracketing & spindlerwork - the cornice @ the roof line is also dominated by a heavy moulding; shingles in the upper gable ends & @ skirt below clapboard on upper level serve as transition into ground floor.
