



The Jason and Maria Simons House, 1889
1230 Park Place
Queen Anne style

The Jason and Maria Simons residence was another house on Park Place designed by John Batschy. This Queen Anne house has very elaborate brickwork on all elevations, including the frieze, the belt course and above the foundation. The brick is molded at the corners of the house. There are four stained glass windows on the main floor. The current owners, Tom and Carrie Mays discovered beautiful pink stone on the façade after they removed several layers of paint.

The interior has several nice features. The split-face staircase leads both to the kitchen and the front foyer. Woodwork throughout the home is quarter-sawn oak. The Mays exposed wood floors that had been covered by carpet. However, to their disappointment, the wood floor they revealed covers the original wood floor.
