This typical one and one half story brick bungalow is built with a dormer on the east side and a hip roof. A prominent feature is the Chicago style triple front double-hung windows. Chicago style is the grouping of windows without walls between them. The porch is asymmetrical and is located on the north side of the house making the entrance somewhat hidden from view.

The interior is common in the bungalow style, entering into the living and dining room with the bedrooms off of those areas. The interior features natural woodwork, and the rooms are decorated in a country style that makes the home not only attractive but warm and comfortable. The basement has been made into a family room filled with collectibles. The Christmas tree brings joy to the family twelve month a year. The kitchen and back porch also reflect the country style with great attention paid to every detail.
