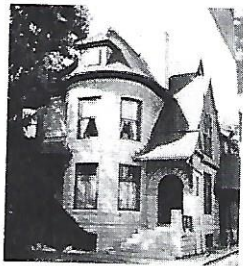


19 *Edward A. Rogers House* *1627 Maine Street*



This stone house is a whimsical combination of Romanesque Revival and Queen Anne styles. It was built circa 1895 for Quincy industrialist Edward A. Rogers. The architect is unknown. The structure uses

various devices to avoid plain, flat walls: an arched entry porch and a porte-cochere to the east, a two-story semi-circular bay, and another bay over the main front porch. A fan-shaped lintel tops the front center window.
