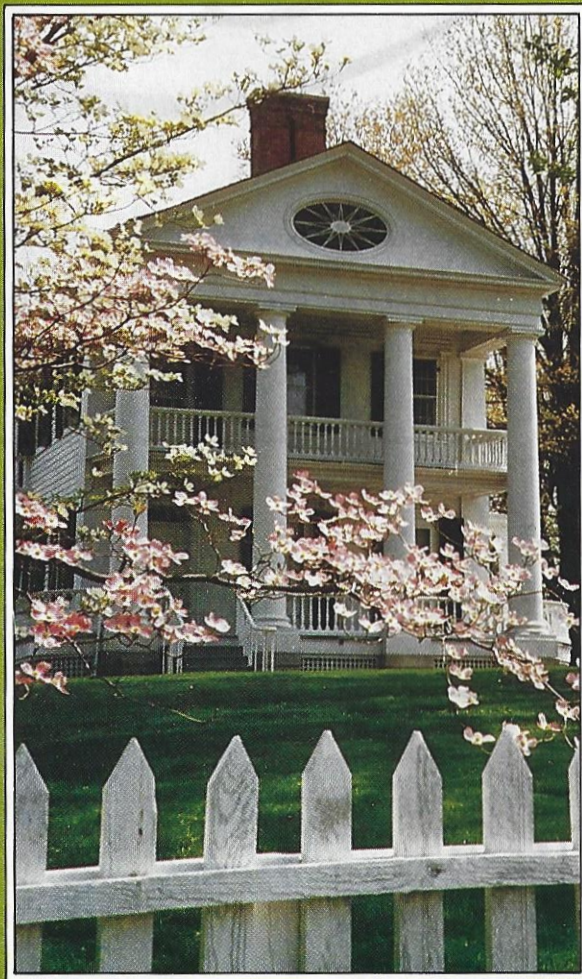
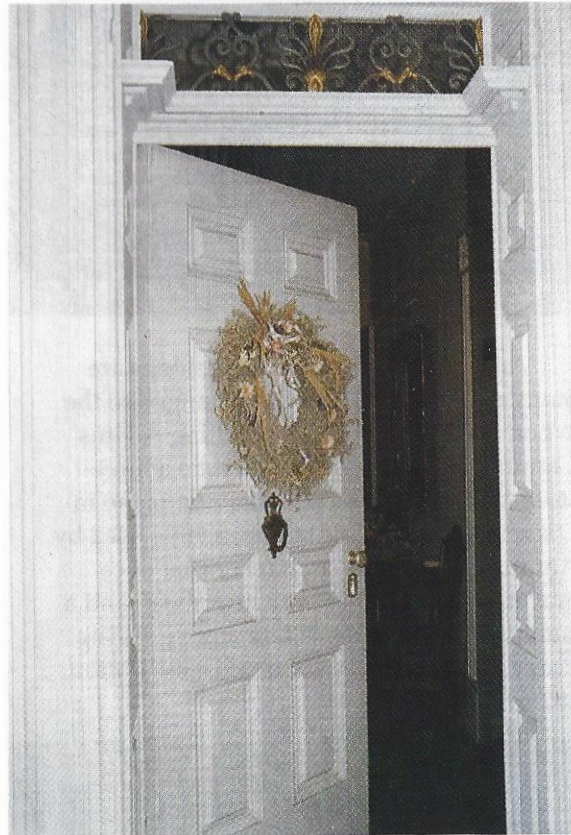

Visitors are welcomed with escorted tours at the restored home of Quincy's founder and early Illinois Governor John Wood. Group tours can be arranged through the Historical Society of Quincy and Adams County. In the adjacent Visitors Center an audio-visual presentation is available, and the Osage Orangerie Gift Shop offers a variety of handcrafted items reminiscent of the early 19th century.

The John Wood Mansion is recognized by historians and architects as one of the Midwest's finest examples of Greek Revival architecture. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The mansion was acquired by the Historical Society of Quincy and Adams County in 1907. The Visitors Center serves as the Society's headquarters and the home of an historical library containing early manuscripts and documents. The collection is available to researchers.
