#### BLDG HISTORY

OWNER PROFILE HENRY C. PFEIFFER WAS A TREASURER OF THE LOCAL UNION NO. 44 OF THE INTERNATIONAL MOLDERS AND FOUNDRY WORKERS WHEN IT WAS GRANTED A NATIONAL CHARTER IN 1874. HE THEN WENT INTO PARTNERSHIP WITH JOHN F. PIEPER, MANUFACTURING SHOW CASES UNDER THE NAME J.F. PIEPER AND COMPANY. THE NAME WAS CHANGED TO THE QUINCY SHOW CASE WORKS WHEN THE BUSINESS WAS INCORPORATED IN 1888. PFEIFFER WAS THE SECRETARY AND TREASURER OF THIS BUSINESS WHICH WAS LOCATED ON 127-135 MAINE ST. IN 1905 HE WAS ONE OF THE ORGANIZERS OF THE MERCHANTILE TRUST AND SAVINGS BANK AND SAT ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FROM 1906-1911. AT THIS TIME HE HAD BECOME THE PRESIDENT OF THE QUINCY SHOW CASE WORKS.
