**Born in 1215. Louis IX
became King of France at 12
years of age. Educated as a
Christian leader by his saintly
mother, St. Louis undertook
Two crusades to the Holy Land.
He died in Tunis in 1270.**

**St. Clare, Virgin
Feast Day – August 12**

**St. Clare renounced all her
wordly goods in spite of the
opposition of her family. She
received the penitential habit
from the hands of St. Francis
of Assisi and founded the
Second Franciscan Order called
“Poor Clares”. She died in 1253.**

ST. MATTHIAS

**He took the place of the
unfortunate Judas who betrayed
his Master. He was selected for
his uprightness of life and the
call of the Holy Spirit.**

ST. JAMES THE GREATER

**Because of the excitement he had
shown and his willingness to
follow, Christ chose him to witness
his agony in the Garden.**

ST. PHILIP

**He asked Jesus for the grace to
know the Father and helped others
to learn through prayer.**

ST. JAMES the LESS

**He was Jesus's cousin and also a
very good friend and follower.**

ST. JUDE (THADDEUS)

**He was honored to be a cousin
and a follower of Jesus.**

ST. SIMON

**A devoted follower as well as a
cousin. Known as “the Zealot”,
who was willing to give his life to
follow the teachings of Jesus.**
