**Description:**

1. Two story running bond red brick
2. Stone foundation
3. Asphalt shingle hip roof with dormers
4. Octagonal tower at southwest corner with spired roof
5. Circular bay on east elevation at first floor level
6. Windows are 1/1 double hung with stone sills
7. Window on the porch next to the door, the transom above the door and the second story window above the one on the porch all have art glass transoms
8. Front door has two double doors with oval windows
9. Simple wood brackets under eave with large carved bracket at southeast corner; dentils around tower roof
10. Dormers have gabled roofs with flared corners with a circular arch window under each
11. Unusual parapet wall on west elevation with circular projection at top, pair of windows centered below at both first and second story levels; second story has stone keystones; first story has flat brick arch (lintel) with pilaster divides
12. Front porch is an addition
13. Carriage house in rear
