

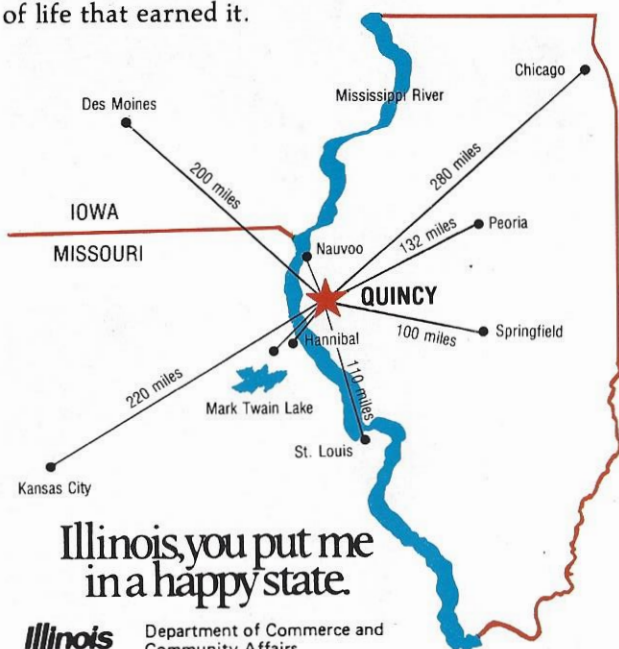

Quincy...twice an all-america city

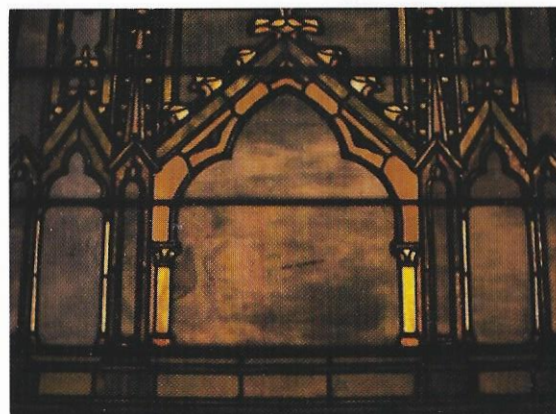

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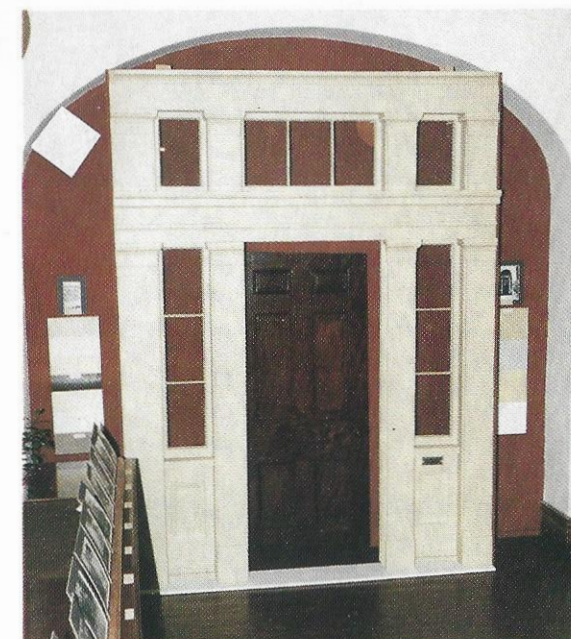
Thomas & Mary White Memorial Window by Tiffany & Co., First Congregational Church, Twelfth & Maine, 1905. Aspirations in Glass.
