Frank Dick, Senior, was the youngest child of John Dick, one of the founders of the Dick Brothers Brewery. He was born in 1862 and died in 1929. He married Rosa Oertle and they had one child, Frank Junior born in 1896. Frank Senior learned the brewing business in Rochester, New York, and in St. Louis before coming to Quincy and working in the family business as superintendent and later treasurer. His son Frank was a lawyer who was once city attorney, a special state's attorney and former city treasurer. He never married. He was very charitable giving not only to local organizations but also to low income families. He was the president of the brewery at the time of its closing in the early 1950s. He lived in the house until his death in 1980.
