Exterior Description:

1. The house begins as a 2 and a half story cube with a hip roof and becomes more complicated as elements connect on all sides
2. The main facade has dormers ornamented with wood shingles and banding
3. A one story porch extends the length of the facade and wraps around to the east elevation
4. The porch is supported by round Doric columns and has a plain wood balustrade
5. A dominant feature of the facade is the wide plate glass window on the first story with the leaded and beveled glass toplight
6. The main entrance has a similar toplight above a double-hinged sash with wood paneled doors
7. The west elevation has a bay represented at the roof line by a gable meeting the hip; a large round arch window opening to the right of the bay holds two double-hung windows and a semi-circular toplight
8. The east elevation has a two story bay; brick string courses break up the mass, as well as the corbelled brick at the cornice
9. The east entry has a simple wood porch with a smaller second story balcony
10. Two ornamental features, besides the leaded and beveled glass, can be found: a repeated pattern of circular elements forms a band around the house just under the eaves, and brackets decorate the facade under the eaves on the left side
