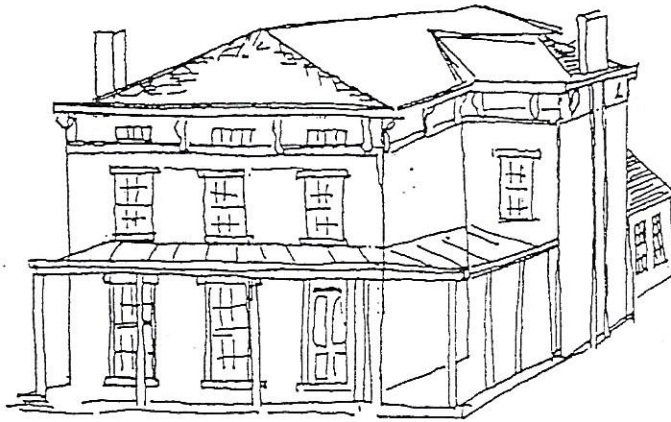


house was now a large Italianate house in 1873, it was a high end rental, or was the home of one of Marsh's daughters and her husband.

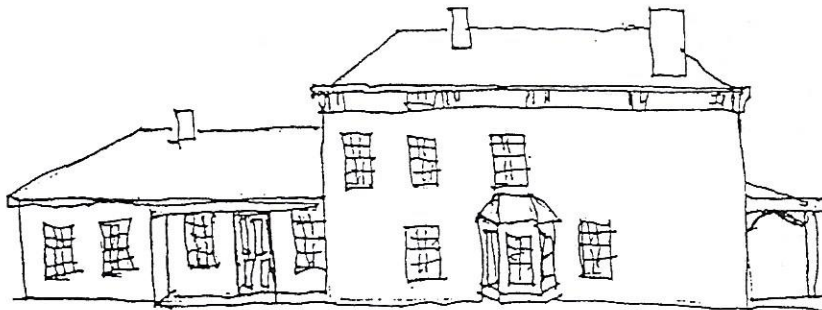
The house was sold in 1903 by Marsh's heirs, Mary M. Sweet et al, for \$3,600.00 to Ferdinand Klene. Mr. Klene and his sons were successful cigar manufacturers who invested in Quincy real estate. It has been a boarding house for most the 20th century. The property remained in the hands of Klene heirs/estate until acquired in 1992 by Friends of the Dr. Fells House for restoration.
