

1 *John Wood House* *425 South 12th Street*



Built in 1835 by Governor John Wood, Quincy's founder, this was one of the first Greek Revival structures built in the area. Historians and architects today proclaim it one of the finest examples of Greek Revival architecture in the entire Midwest. Constructed by master builder John Cleveland, the house was originally located on the west side of 12th Street and was moved to its present site in 1864. The white frame house with its pediment, four Doric columns, four massive chimneys, and elegant details, is now the headquarters of the Historical Society of Quincy and Adams County.
