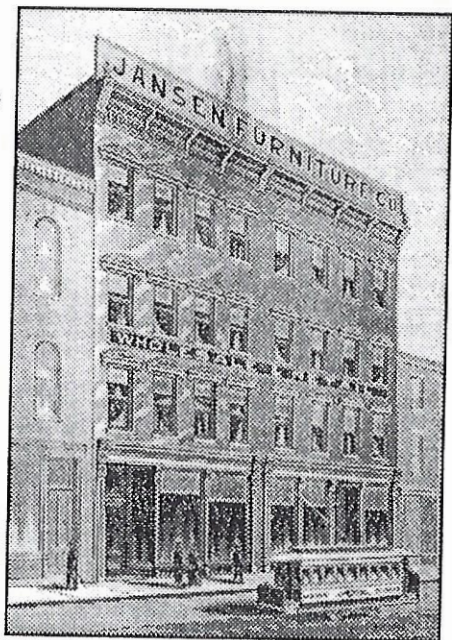
Jansen Furniture Company

This four story, brick Italianate building was originally the home of the F. W. Jansen Furniture Company. Jansen came to Quincy from Prussia in 1836. He found employment as a cabinet maker but eventually saved enough money to open his own furniture factory and store which became one of the largest in the state. Around 1891 this building was remodelled to add the fourth story, the cornice and the metal window hoods.



Recently, the building was purchased by Terry Austin and Jerry Jackson. The second floor houses Austin and Associates, an engineering and design firm. The owners plan to lease out the lower level and hope to restore the facade in the near future.
