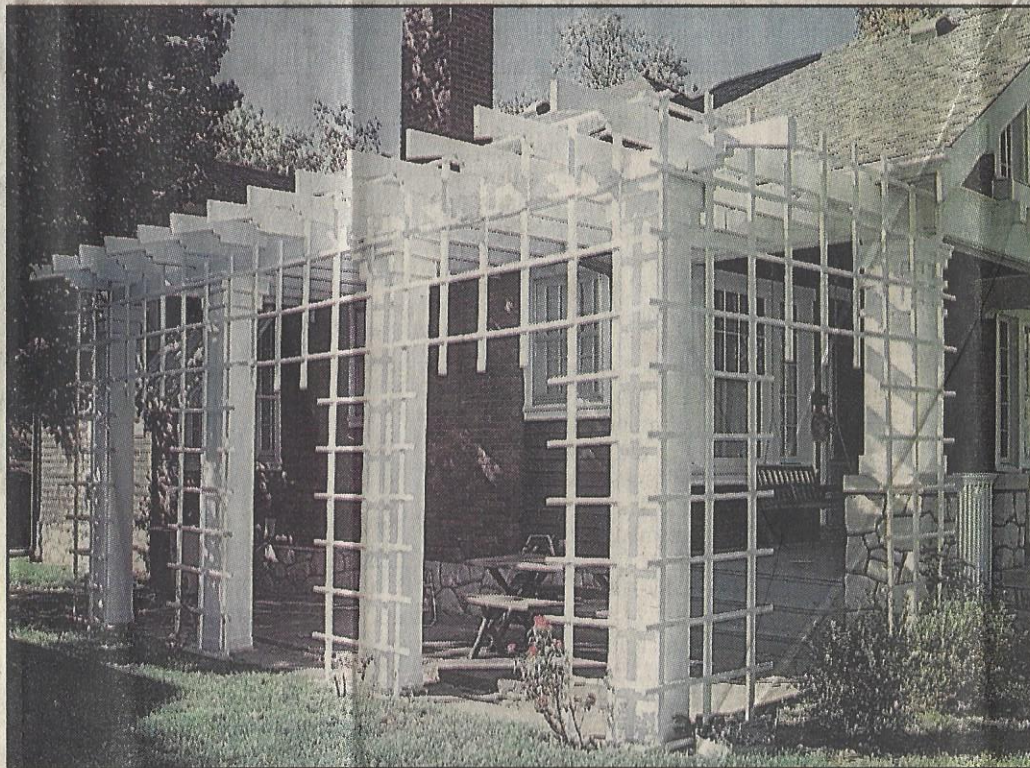

## It's probably not necessary to have new gas furnace checked

**Q:** I had a high-efficiency gas furnace installed two years ago. I had it serviced last year and the contractor just called about servicing it this year too. Is it worthwhile having it serviced each year? — Ann H.

**A:** With a brand new gas furnace, it is probably not necessary to have it serviced every year, but check your warranty requirements.

If you have central air-conditioning, which should be serviced annually, you might as well have the furnace checked at the same time for a small additional fee.

Other than having the heat go off unexpectedly, carbon monoxide (CO) gas is the major concern. Always use CO detectors near the furnace and in your bedrooms.
