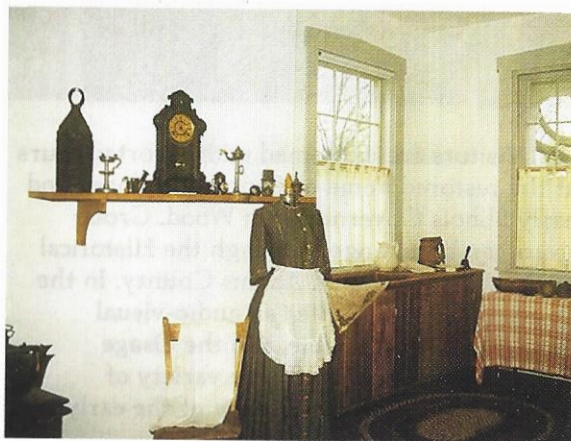


Among the mansion's furnishings are many personal items which belonged to the Wood family, and objects recalling Adams County's early days. They include a three-story Victorian dollhouse; the first piano in Quincy; Quincy-made stoves; a table used by Abraham Lincoln; a chandelier that once graced a Mississippi River steamboat; and a sideboard used in the White House during President Andrew Jackson's administration, 1829-1837.
