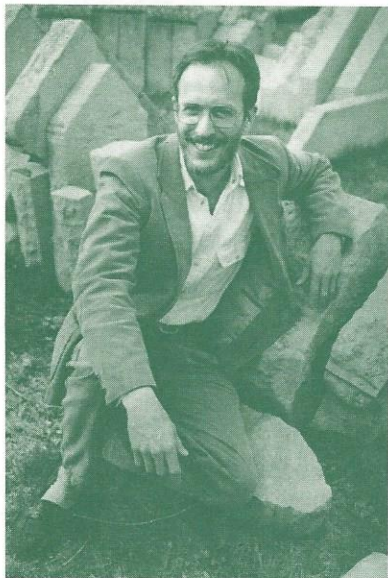




EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR APPOINTED

Larson has extensive experience in historic preservation in the Twin Cities and maintains a private practice in architectural research and historical design. He recently was guest curator and designer for "The Spirit of

H.H. Richardson on the Midland Prairies," a traveling exhibition organized by the University of Minnesota Art Museum. The exhibit was on display at the Gardner Museum this past fall.

Larson will serve as a part-time consultant until beginning full-time duties August 1. He and his 15 year old son Marcos are looking forward to living in a city so rich with architectural heritage.
