**Description:**

1. Two story red brick
2. Complex roof line consisting of a steeply pitched hipped roof with prominent front gable and dormer
3. Stone foundation
4. Patterned masonry
5. Bands of decorative brick work
6. Elongated chimney with molded corners
7. Paired windows in gable with decorative wood trim
8. Windows with multi-pane upper sash, transoms over all first story windows with stained glass transom over front picture window
9. Double front doors
10. Full facade front porch with brick pillars and wood rails (most likely modified from on original spindle work version)

**History:**

William Campbell was associated with Campbell Brothers Lime and Stone Masonry located in 1892 at 920 Hampshire. The Campbell family owned a lot of woodland in the area and used the wood cut from these areas for their kilns.
