

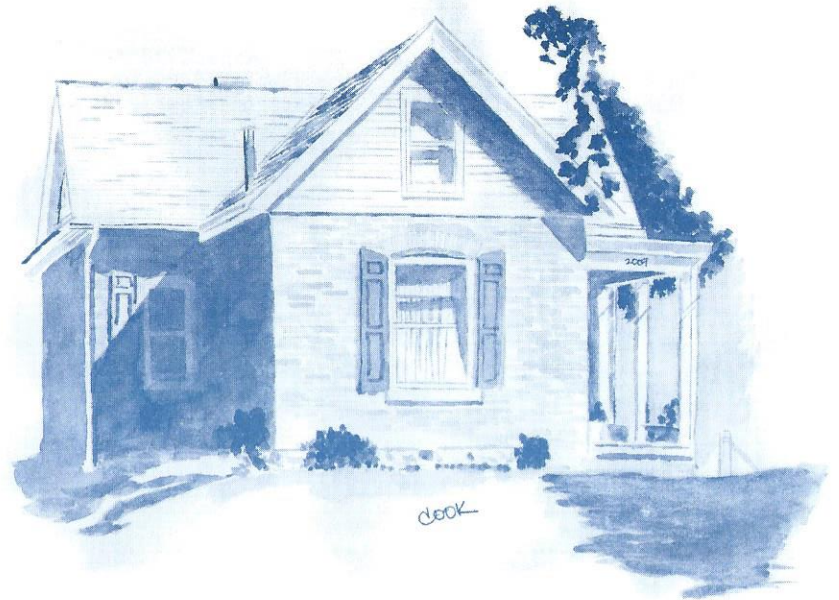


1418 Spring

This is a simple 1 1/2-story L-shaped house, constructed with red brick, and laid in a common bond pattern with Flemish bond at every 8th course, all set on a stone foundation. The roof shape is a clear cross-gable that has fascia boards curving inward at the ends.

The openings of the house are simple as well. The doors are segmented arch openings with toplights above. The window openings are also segmental arches with double hung windows. The top sash is divided into 3 vertical panes with a single pane on the bottom.



2009 Elm

This is a 1 1/2-story brick house on a stone foundation and is covered by a cross-gable at roof.

There is a one-story entry porch on the southeast corner of the house. The square, wood columns that support the porch are defined by bands at the top and base.

The double-hung window openings are supported by segmental arches and stone lintels. The door openings are also supported by segmental arches and have toplights above the door.
