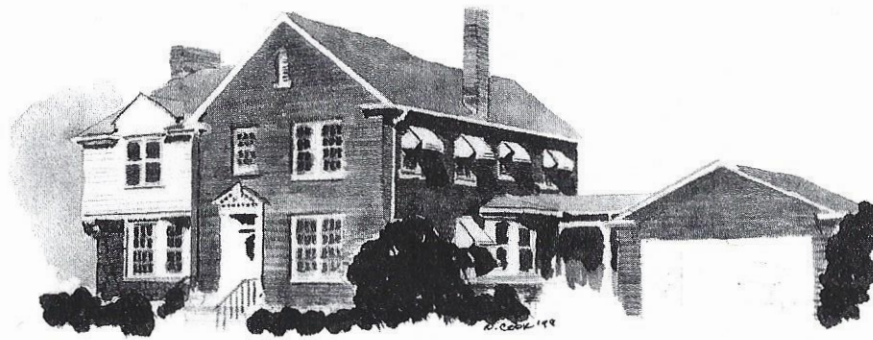




Dr. Carson K. & Mabel Gabriel House

This is believed to have been the last project of architect George Behrensmeyer. The exceptional floor plan lends itself to both beauty and function and has more of a Georgian interior layout.

On the interior, there is an arched elliptical opening in the reception hall. To the left, is the living room with a large fireplace and colonial revival style mantle. The three bay window faces Old Kentucky Road and double French doors lead to a porch.

To the right is the dining room, butler's pantry with breakfast nook and the kitchen.

Going down, the basement has a wonderful surprise. The den has an oversized stone fireplace. The current owners truly enjoy this room, as will you. Notice the two brick columns in the basement. This is the structural support system for the house.

Upstairs, the four bedrooms are handsomely decorated. A great deal of thought has gone into every detail of this house from both the architect, George Behrensmeyer, to the decorating by the Grimm's, the current owners.

They have filled their home with beautiful antiques and have kept the architectural integrity of the home intact.
