The original (eastern) half of this structure was designed in 1892 by the Chicago architects Patton & Fisher for Quincy bankers Lorenzo and Charles H. Bull; the western half was designed in 1906 by prominent Quincy architect Ernest M. Wood. The building is in the Romanesque Revival style and is perhaps Quincy's finest example of that style. Constructed of pink Missouri granite, the building's exterior is graced by handsomely carved Romanesque decorative details, massive iron and oak doors, and beautiful curvilinear window grilles of wrought iron.
