The Frank Kehlenbrink Home

Frank Kehlenbrink was listed in the 1878 City Directory as residing at 15th and Adams and was said to be a wine grower. Kehlenbrink's property was the Kehlenbrink Addition and ran from Adams to Jackson Street and 15th to 14th Streets.

In the Abstract of Title for the home his name is F. H. Kehlenbrink but the city directory has Frank Kellenbring. Misspellings of surnames were common in the old city directories.

The Queen Anne style brick home was one of the finest in the neighborhood when it was built. The cross-gabled roofline also has a bay on the opposite side of the el. The original front porch was replaced in the 1920's with a craftsman style version. A shingled gable highlights the front of the house.

After a fire last year the current owners have renovated the entire house. The kitchen area is of particular interest because the owners enjoy cooking and also have a catering business.

Off the south side of the home is the pool area that is surrounded by beautiful accent gardening.
