

22 *DeLafayette Musselman House*

2203 Maine Street

Designed by John Batschy and built in 1888 for the founder of Gem City Business College, this massive house is a fine example of Queen Anne style and uses bull-nose brick construction (the corners of the house are rounded). Dominated by a tower on the west side, the house is decorated with contrasting stonework. The four graceful porches on the house lighten its appearance. Recently restored, the house won an award from the National Trust for Historic Preservation in 1991.
