The Quincy Preservation Commission met on April 4, 1995, and voted to recommend to the City Council that your property, The Samuel & Jane Brown House, located at 822 N. Sixth Street, be officially designated a Quincy Local Landmark. A written report will be sent to the City Council within 30 days.

The Quincy City Council will review the report and recommendation of the Preservation Commission and then vote whether or not to officially designate this property. Although the Preservation Commission is required by ordinance to notify the property owner of all proceedings, the City Council is not. Please watch the newspaper, or call the City Clerk's office at 228-4500, if you wish to attend any City Council meetings regarding this designation. You may also call the Commission office at 228-4514 with any questions.

Following the vote of the City Council, our office will send you a copy of the ordinance officially designating your property. If the City Council disapproves designation, we will notify you by mail of this decision.

We are pleased that you have agreed for the Quincy Preservation Commission to proceed with Preliminary Review and possible nomination and designation of your property at 822 North Sixth Street.

This house is a fine example of Queen Anne and Eastlake architecture, and due to your outstanding restoration and rehabilitation, is an anchor preservation property in the North end of Quincy. If designated, 822 North Sixth Street will be a worthy addition to the Quincy Local Landmark program and bring additional recognition to this important structure.

Included is a copy of the application for 822 North Sixth Street. The application will be presented to the Quincy Preservation Commission for Preliminary Review at the February 7, 1995 meeting to be held in the meeting room of the Quincy Public Library.

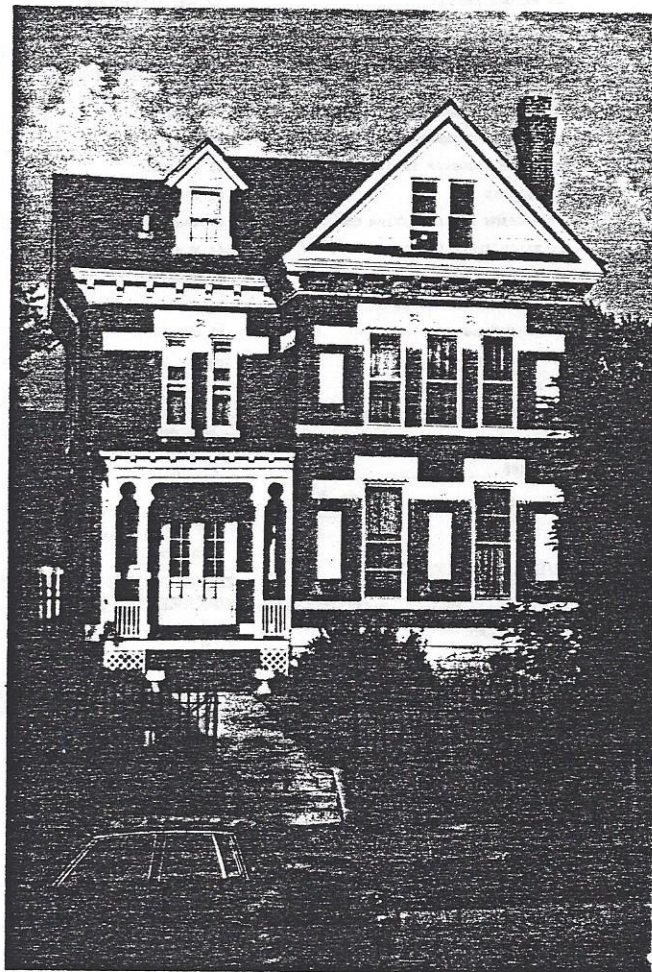
