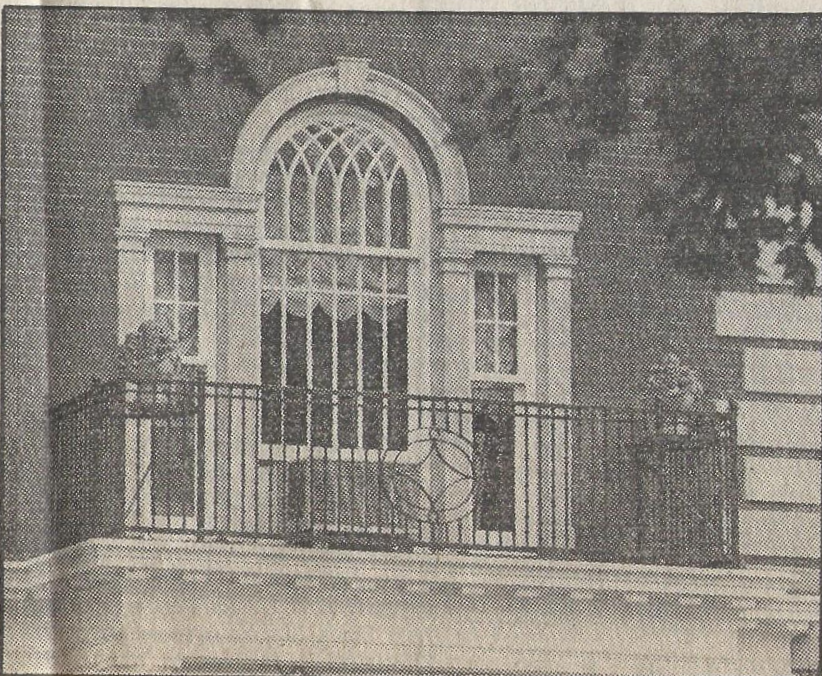

Fred Wilms built this Georgian Revival style house early in the 20th century. He sold the property to A.W.D. Weis in 1916 and Mr. and Mrs. Robert Kelly purchased the property in 1963. The brick structure is considered one of the purest samples of any architectural style in the city. Originally the coach house in the rear of the property and a house which faces Jersey Street (which was the gardener's home) were a part of the property. Both structures were later sold and a garage was built on the east side of the house. There is a semi-circular side porch on the east side.
