**Description:**

1. Limestone foundation
2. Simple drop wood siding on first floor
3. Wood shingles on second floor on the front facade; board and batten on the second floor back
4. Cross-gabled roof
5. Second story bay on south side with gabled roof
6. Dormer on north side with gabled roof
7. Octagonal bay window, first floor south
8. Wrap around porch; wood ceiling
9. Porch has stone piers supporting square wood columns
10. Eaves of gable decorated with quatrefoil cut-outs which can also be found along back fascia board of gables
11. Decorative brick chimney with rounded brick corners and a stained glass window centered at first floor level on north side; second brick chimney on south side
12. North side has second story porch with keyhole opening on east and round opening on north

**History:**

Very little is known about Mrs. Johanna Wallace other than that she was a widow while living in this home. She was born September 17, 1829 and died December 31, 1911. She is buried in Woodland Cemetery. She originally purchased the property on which the house was built from Henry Asbury.
