The Boeker-Helferink Duplex is architecturally significant as an intact, large-scale example of vernacularized Greek Revival architecture constructed for occupation by at least one of its original builders. It was built in 1859 by local carpenters Frederick Boeker (c. 1820-?; also spelled Beker) and Henry Helferink (1819-1872; also spelled Helfring). Helferink resided in the east unit until 1865 or 1866. It is unclear whether Boeker resided in the west unit, but it was sold separately in 1864. The two units have maintained separate ownership until modern times. *(see continuation sheet)*

Provide legal description of Landmark as described on deed:

The east 25 feet 1 inch of Lot 3 Block 60 of John Wood's Addition to the City of Quincy (718 Kentucky); and the west 15 feet 9 inches of Lot 3 and the east 10 feet of Lot 4 Block 60 of John Wood's Addition to the City of Quincy (720 Kentucky).
