**Description:**

1. Red brick trimmed in stone with a hip roof covered in slate
2. Elements that confuse the simple rectangular form are dormers, a bay on the east elevation, a semi-circular tower on the facade topped with a spire, a box bay on the west elevation, a simple one-story porch, an octagonal bay on the east elevation topped with a mansard roof and two tall brick chimneys
3. Decorative brick patterns on the chimneys
4. Tower has wood shingle surface and art glass at the center window
5. Patterned wood shingles cover the pediments of the dormers and porch as well as the west box bay
6. Wood panels ornament surfaces of the house such as on the facade's dormer and the box bay
7. Stone serves as sills and lintels as well as banding on the octagonal bay
8. A large plate glass window with toplight is a main feature of the facade
9. Main entrance has a toplight above and double-hinged sash with large paneled doors decorated by exaggerated hinges and door knob plate
