

12 *Heidbreder Hagemann Drug Store*

1001 North 5th Street

Designed by Quincy architect Martin Geise, this building remains substantially unaltered in appearance since its 1906 construction. An outstanding example of early 20th-century commercial architecture, with a corner bay and bull's-eye windows, the structure remained an active pharmacy until it became the Pharmacy Museum of Quincy & Adams County in 1984. In its heyday, the drug store served not only as a business but as a community gathering place.
