

## **Anthony Crane house 2834 Carnoustie Lane**

The Crane house is the first new home to be featured on the Quincy Preserves! architectural tour. The home earned the spot after participants last year expressed interest in interior design of new homes, said Carol Mason, tour publicity chairman.

Anthony Crane, a local architect, designed the convective loop style home in 1984 for he and his wife, Trish. Construction began in August 1987 and was completed in April 1988.

The home contains 3,800 square feet of living space on two floors, a partial basement with 545 square feet, an attic storage space with 360 square feet and a three-car 672-square-foot garage.

The house is equipped with a passive solar design that provides functional living space with total energy efficiency. Energy features include double wall construction, air chambers, exterior subterranean air intakes, carefully placed window
