Behrensmeyer, the architect for the Western Catholic Union Building, the Quincy Junior High School, and many other public and

private buildings in the city, designed this Prairie Style house circa 1917 as his personal residence. The house shows all the traits of the style: a two-story main structure with a single-story porch, a low-pitched roof with deep overhangs, a contrasting stucco friezeband under the eaves, and a broad, flat chimney.
