

14. Two of the most outstanding features of the home are located in the entry hall: the exceptional open staircase with its outstanding newel posts and the arch over the fireplace
15. Also to be noted is the beading on the entry foyer arch, pocket doors of the living room, music room and dining room as well as the mantels
16. All downstairs rooms and several rooms upstairs have oak floors with borders
17. Back part of the house uses pine woodwork in the kitchen, pantry and the second floor back bedrooms
18. Hardware throughout the house is solid brass; chandeliers throughout the house are original and similar in design
19. Originally there were three fireplaces; the living room one has been plastered over leaving only the ones in the entry hall and music room
