-George Dashwood was born in England in 1852 and came to the United States when he was six. He eventually settled in Kentucky and became a pharmacist. George moved to Fort Worth, Texas where he met and married his wife Sarah Cole Havens. George and Sarah moved to Quincy where he opened his own pharmacy at 528 Maine Street. Sarah's mother and stepfather, Mr. & Mrs. Gorham J. Cottrell, built this beautiful Colonial Revival home for them. The Cottrells had the Lucius Kingman House, which originally stood on this corner, moved to its present location directly behind the Dashwood House at 120 N. 18th. By the time he and Sarah moved into this home, he was having tremendous success in the real estate business. George died in 1922 and Sarah in 1948
