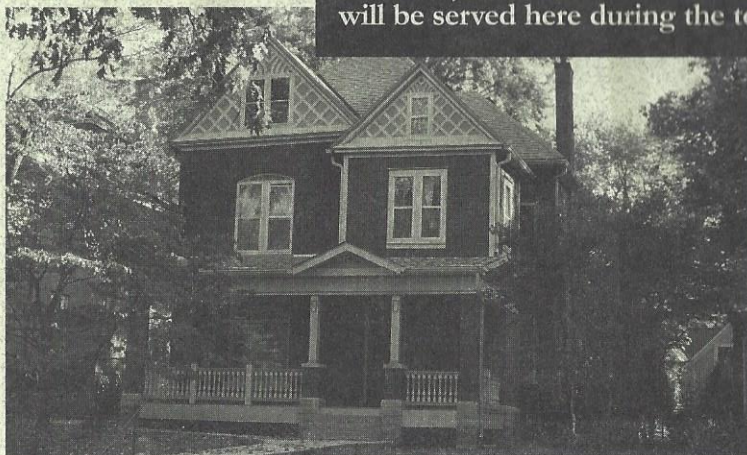

1248 Park Place
Late Queen Ann Style • 1893
Henry & Emma Borstadt House

This late Queen Anne style house was constructed in 1893 for J. Henry Borstadt, the foreman for the EM Miller and Company, carriage and omnibus builders. The right side of the second story of the façade, right gable, and porch were added at a later date and do not follow the brick/stone requirement for the neighborhood. The original house features much of the detailing seen throughout the neighborhood. There is decorated brickwork on the frieze. The double window has the carved shallow arch lintel under a flat segmented brick arch. On the east side, the first story bay, gable and chimney resemble the design of the neighboring houses at 1244 and 1240. The chimney is pilastered with molded corners and stone detail in the corner.

This house, currently under restoration, and not furnished, will give you an idea of what a house looks like before new owners can move into an historic structure. Visitors can also have their hot chocolate or coffee and try a Christmas cookie in this house.
