

15 *Cruttenden/Tibbetts House* *1200 Park Place*



Designed circa 1887-89 by Swiss-born architect John Batschy, this is a fine example of the Queen Anne style. A round tower extends from the top of the wrap-around front porch through the second and third floors and above the roof ridge. Patterned shingles are used in the front of the gable area and repeated on the circular sides of the tower. The most noticeable feature of the house is the large round window east of the entry which is surrounded by decorative stained glass. A Palladian window graces the third floor gable. The front porch has been modernized.
